Financial Accounting I and II (Fall Required Core Courses)		
	Qualifications	Actions
Category 1	Certified Public Accountant	Upon Student Services receipt of CPA documentation, student is granted waiver from ACCT 60100 (Financial Accounting I) and ACCT 60120 (Financial Accounting II).
Category 2	Undergraduate or Masters degree in Accounting within the last four years from a U.S. college or university.	May be eligible for waiver from ACCT 60100 (Financial Accounting I) and ACCT 60120 (Financial Accounting II). Transcript presented to Student Services for review; potential interview with Department Chair.
Substitute Course	Replacement course as selected in consultation with Student Services academic advisor.	

Finance (Fall Required Core Course)		
	Qualifications	Actions
Category 1	Completion of CFA Level I.	Upon Student Services receipt of CFA documentation, student is granted waiver from FIN 60500 (Finance).
Category 2	Undergraduate or Masters degree in Finance within the last four years from a U.S. college or university.	May be eligible for waiver from FIN 60500 (Finance). Transcript presented to Student Services for review; potential interview with Department Chair.
Substitute Course	Replacement course as selected in consultation with Student Services academic advisor.	

Introduction to Business Analytics (Fall Required Core Course)		
	Qualifications	Actions
Category 1	CFA Level III Candidate. Appointment to take the CFA Level III exam must be within 10 months or less.	Upon Student Services receipt of CFA III registration documentation, student is granted waiver from ITAO 60200 (Introduction to Business Analytics).
Category 2	Student has earned a "B" grade or higher in a Masters or PhD level Statistics course within the last four years from a U.S. college or university.	May be eligible for waiver from ITAO 60200 (Introduction to Business Analytics). Transcript presented to Student Services for review; potential interview with Department Chair.
Substitute Course	Replacement course as selected in consultation with Student Services academic advisor.	

Managerial Economics (Fall Required Core Course)		
	Qualifications	Actions
Category 1	Student has earned a "B" grade or higher in at least four undergraduate and/or Masters level courses in Economics.	May be eligible for waiver from FIN 60210 (Managerial Economics). Transcript presented to Student Services for review; potential interview with Department Chair.
Substitute Course	Replacement course as selected in consultation with Student Services academic advisor.	

Investments (Fall or Spring Course Required for the Investments Concentration)		
	Qualifications	Actions
Category 1	Completion of CFA Level I.	Upon Student Services receipt of CFA documentation, student is granted waiver from FIN 70670 (Investments).
Category 2	Undergraduate or Masters degree in Finance within the last four years from a U.S. college or university.	May be eligible for waiver from FIN 70670 (Investments). Transcript presented to Student Services for review; potential interview with Department Chair.
Substitute Course	Replacement course as selected in consultation with Student Services academic advisor.

	Qualifications	Actions
Category 1	Lean Six Sigma or equivalent certification.	Upon Student Services receipt of certification documentation, student is granted waiver from ITAO 60800 (Process Analytics).
Substitute Course	Replacement course as selected in consultation with Student Services academic advisor.
