2. Maintain a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0;
3. Complete a minimum of (1) concentration track;
4. Maintain full-time student status, which is a minimum of (4) credit hours per module
5. Complete a minimum of (2) Interterm credits
6. All Four-Year MBA/JD students are required to complete one communication elective and one ethics elective.
